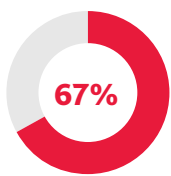


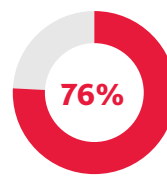
Health Industries (Life Sciences & Pharmaceuticals)

This infographic highlights key findings from **research commissioned by BDO**—exposing today's privacy blind spots and the biggest opportunities to build trusted, transparent AI driven care.

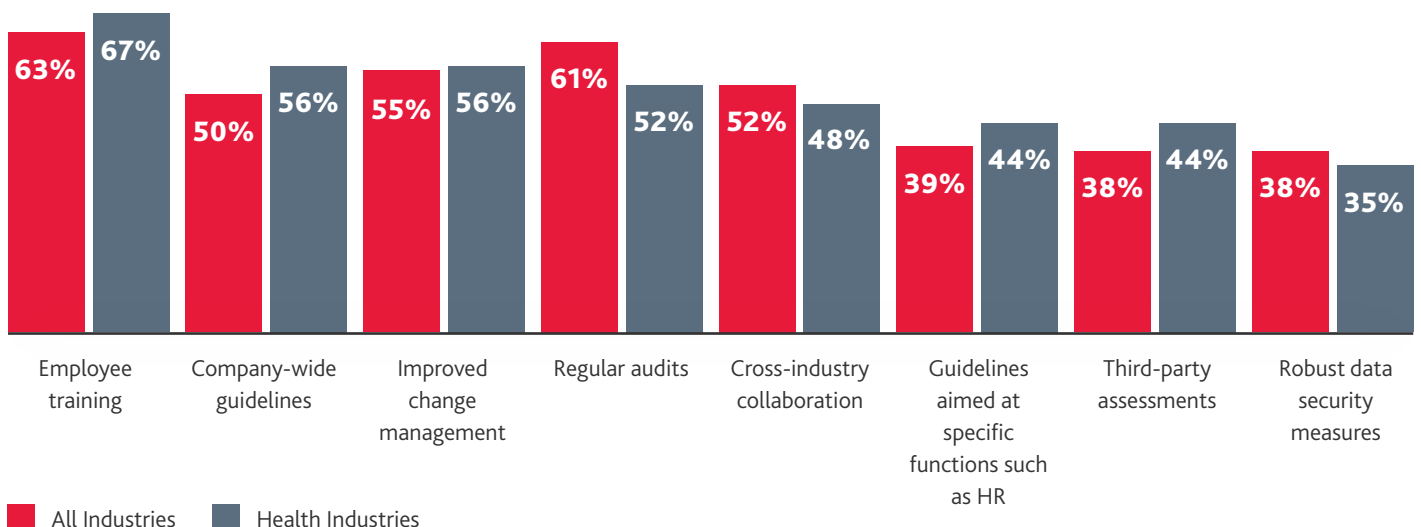

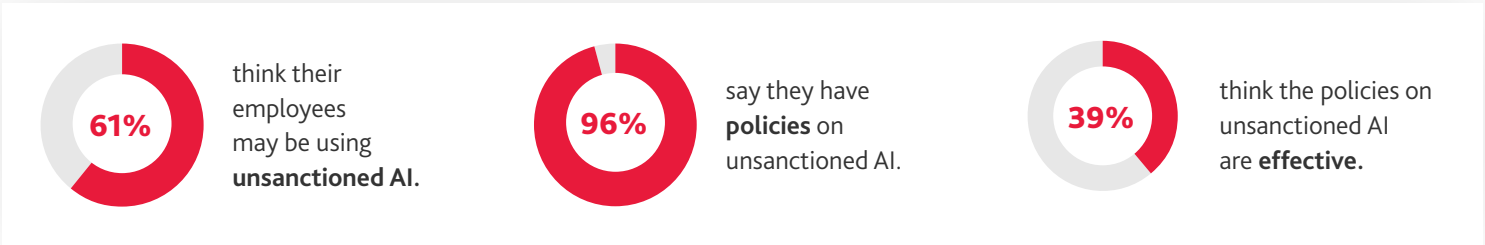
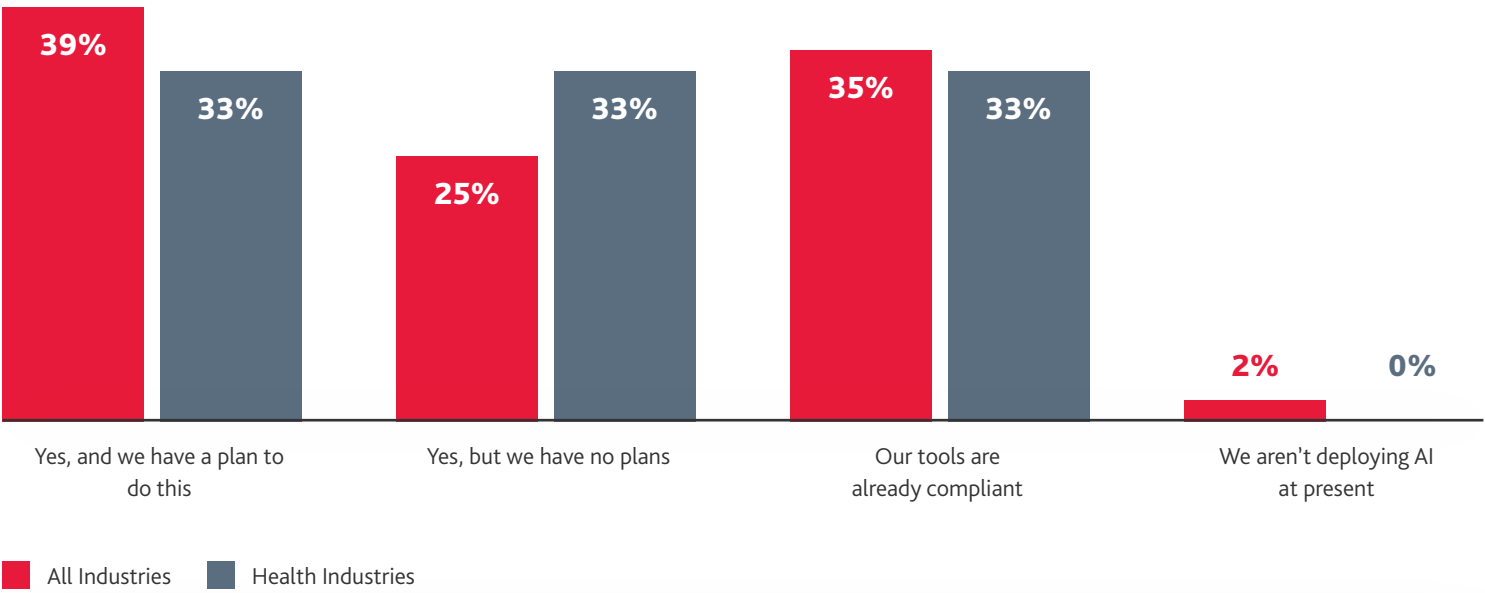


Only **22%** of health industries assess AI risk both before implementation **and** continuously when in use.
