BDO aims to foster trust and confidence among its stakeholders, safeguard security, and contribute to the positive impact of AI on its personnel, clients and communities.

As such, BDO has adopted a Responsible AI Policy comprised of seven Responsible AI Principles aimed at emphasizing the ethical, governance and security safeguards that are vital for BDO to manage the risks and capture the benefits associated with the design and application of AI technologies.

Secure and Robust:

We seek to integrate comprehensive security measures into the development and deployment processes for AI systems to fortify such systems against potential threats or vulnerabilities and to help protect information.

Bias Managed Development and Deployment:

We look to engage diverse perspectives in the design and operation of AI systems.

Transparent and Explainable:

We aim to provide transparency into the design, development, function, and application of AI systems, as well as how decisions are made by AI systems.

Safe and Relibale:

We aim to use AI systems that are consistent, reliable and function appropriately.

Documented and Monitored:

We document design decisions, development protocols and alignment with BDO's Responsible AI Principles for AI systems as well as establish standards for monitoring, evaluation, and improvement.

Data Rights and Integrity are Respected:

We respect data privacy, security, confidentiality, and intellectual property ownership considerations in the development and deployment of AI systems.

Accountability and Human Oversight:

We endeavor to establish accountability for the proper functioning of the AI systems developed or operated by BDO and designate responsibility for the actions, decisions, outcomes, and compliance of such AI system.
